
Title: Position Indication Marking of Actuated Valve Assemblies to Prevent Risk



Note 7 – Ensure all orientation marks are aligned as shown in Fig 1a when assembly is de-energised.

Note 8 – If dismantling of assembly is necessary, e.g. for maintenance:

- a) Prior to dismantling, ensure all components are marked as shown in Fig 1a.
- b) immediately after dismantling, note the position of the actuator or spring output drive, and the valve stem. Mark components and/or record positions to ensure alignment is maintained on reassembly.
- c) repaint centre punch marks if necessary.

Note 9 - Failure to comply with notes 6, 7 & 8 may result in a safety hazard due to incorrect valve operation.

Note 10 - IMPORTANT! Centre punch marks painted red always on open end of bracket as shown in Fig 2a.


